**LOCAL RULES**

- OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 27)**  
Beyond all fences, walls & white posts defining the course boundaries. Left of the white posts when playing the 3rd, 6th, 7th & 9th. Right of the white posts when playing the 8th. Out of Bounds markers are an integral part of the course (Rule 24).
- WATER HAZARDS (Rule 26)**  
Ponds and open ditches defined by yellow posts.
- LATERAL WATER HAZARDS (Rule 26)**  
Open ditches defined by red posts.
- IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (Rule 24-2)**  
All fixed artificial structures other than boundary walls and fences. Including all paths, bridges and roadways.

- STAKED TREES (Rule 24-2b(i))**  
If a staked tree interferes with stance or swing, the ball MUST be lifted and dropped within one club length not nearer the hole. Any tree that is shorter in height than the length of a driver shall be classed the same as a staked tree. Trees that are supported by canes or protected by plastic sleeves are not classified as being staked and therefore do not qualify for relief.
- GROUND UNDER REPAIR (Rule 25-1)**  
Filled in drainage ditches and white lined areas.
- STONES IN BUNKERS (Rule 24-1)**  
Are movable obstructions.
- GREENSIDE SPRINKLERS (Rule 24-2)**  
A ball lying within two club lengths of a sprinkler head which intervenes on the line of play, may be lifted and dropped not nearer the hole without penalty.

GOLFERS MUST BE AWARE OF THE POSSIBLE DANGER TO THE PUBLIC OVER THE BOUNDARY FENCE WHEN PLAYING THE 1ST, 3RD, 7TH, 10TH, 11TH, 13TH AND 18TH. ALSO THAT INDIVIDUAL GOLFERS ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE PERSONAL INSURANCE TO INDEMNIFY THE COURSE AGAINST RESPONSIBILITY
